



Installation Instructions**



INCLUDED HARDWARE:

1	1	Bronco 3 rd Brake Light Relocation Bracket
2	6	M6 x 25mm Plastic Thread Forming Screw
3	4	M6 x 1 Nylon-Insert Lock Nut
4	4	M6 Washer
5	4	M6 x 1 x 20mm Flanged Hex Head Bolt

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

- 10mm Socket & Wrench
- T30 Torx Driver / Bit



NOTES:

All pictures shown are for illustration purposes only. Actual product may vary due to product enhancement.

Does NOT fit Bronco Sport models.

INSTALLATION:

1. Remove spare tire.
2. Remove (x4) screws holding 3rd brake light assembly to the spare tire carrier using a T30 Torx bit (**Figure 1**).

3. Using provided M6 hardware (x4) M6 x 1 x 20mm Flange Bolts, Washers, & Lock Nuts), install the 3rd brake light relocation bracket onto the spare tire carrier and torque to 77 in-lbs (**Figure 2**).

1. **NOTE:** For hard top model, mount bracket to opposite side of carrier for additional wiper clearance (**Figure 3**).

2. Using a T30 Torx bit, install (x6) provided M6 plastic thread forming screws into the 3rd brake light assembly (**Figure 4**).

3. Reinstall spare tire (**Figure 5**).

POST-INSTALLATION:

1. Check for proper torque on all fasteners. Check clearance between all rotating, mobile, fixed, and hot parts.

MAINTENANCE: After 500 miles, re-torque all fasteners (recommended every 1000 miles thereafter). Have all suspension, driveline, and steering components inspected by a certified technician during routine maintenance (recommended every 3000 miles).
